CUT TO:

BREAK
(TRANSITION)

INT. HOTEL ROOM - MIDNIGHT

ACTION

Kate and Jack are watching tv. The room has an expensive, rosy glow, and we HEAR rock MUSIC playing in the b.g. Jack snaps off the bathroom light as he crosses from one side of the room to the other.

ACTION2

Kate throws off her shoes slips onto the big sofa, HUMS along with a song, and glances cutely at Jack

PARENTHETICAL

KATE

(sweetly droll)

Wanna go shopping tomorrow, pal?

SideBySide
Parenthetical
at ALT + I.

SIDE-BY-SIDE
DIALOGUE
TABLE
(SEE HELP)

JACK

What? Do we really have to? Couldn't we stay in

KATE

(even louder)

C'mon now, Jack--you can't go back on your promise!
