That doesn't change the fact that if I didn't know you better, I'd think you were trying to sabotage me.

JESSICA

Sabotage? Sabo - Oh, no. It was nothing like that.

CHET

You realize that I'm trying to help Michael sell his house.
Otherwise...

MICHAEL (O.S.)
Otherwise, I won't be able to complete my purchase of her father's house.

Jessica turns around and sees Michael and Rod over her shoulder.

MICHAEL (CONT'D)
Isn't that right, Rod?

JESSICA

Oh, boy.

INT. JESSICA'S PARENTS' HOUSE - KITCHEN - LATER

-START

Jessica sits at the table, Rod PACES around her. It's as if Jessica is 8 years old, and her father is getting ready to ground her.

ROD

What in the world were you thinking?

JESSICA I don't see what the big deal is -

ROD

The big deal is that you're misrepresenting yourself.

JESSICA

You make me sound like I burned the house down. I just suggested they look at another house.

ROD

You're interfering.

JESSICA

Who's side are you on? You're out eating lunch with the enemy -

ROD
The enemy? You're really over reacting, dear. You know if you got to know Michael, he's actually a very nice guy.

JESSICA I'm sure he is.

ROD He's available.

JESSICA

Dad.

Rod sits down.

ROD

What is it?

JESSICA

What?

ROD
This isn't like you at all. Are you alright?

JESSICA
Of course I'm not alright. This is my house and you're selling it to a stranger!

Your house? Your house? Sweetheart. You haven't been here in three years. And now that your mother and I are moving out of town, you're finally dropping by for a visit?

JESSICA It's not like that.

How is then? Please explain it to me. Because I've missed you.

JESSICA

Oh, dad.

They look at each other...no one's breaking down. Not yet...

JESSICA (CONT'D) When...Barry died. I...didn't want to...be here.

ROD
Why wouldn't you want to be around your family?

JESSICA
Because...the most important
part...of my family was gone.

That does it, they hug each other.

JESSICA (CONT'D)
But. After a few years in the
City...without him. That doesn't
feel like home either...

Jessica laughs, as if remembering the clouds clearing ...

JESSICA (CONT'D)
And one day. A few months ago. I
thought to myself. I like it. At
home. I always did. When we moved
here - Remember when we went
camping here in the summers?
Before you built the house -

ROD It's why I built the house -

JESSICA
I know! I left this place because of Barry. He wanted to live in the City. I...

Jessica drifts off.

JESSICA (CONT'D)
I just want a home of my own now.
And...believe me dad, I wasn't
trying to avoid you and mom and...I
just wish you weren't moving so far
away. But I can promise you this:

ROD

What?

JESSICA I will definitely visit you in Florida.

Rod LAUGHS. Then...

ROD Your mom and I would like that.

They look at each other.

ROD (CONT'D)
I just wish you would have said something earlier.

JESSICA I'm sorry, dad.



ROD
I'm sorry, too. But for now,
you've just got to let this house
go. It breaks my heart. It does.
But it's just too late.

JESSICA

I don't know.

ROD
Sweetheart. I raised you to be honest. To be thoughtful. No house is worth compromising your honor. As tough as it is. This is just a house. You can make a home anywhere.

Jessica sits with that a long moment.

TAME DAY

The DOG and Madeline watch MICHAEL as he CARVES WOOD, breaking animatedly about:

MICHAEL A time capsule.

MADELINE
